In accordance with MSCHE Bylaws and Commission policy, CEOs are entitled to vote to approve policy.

Title of Policy: Peer Evaluator Policy

Status of Policy: New Policy

Description: The proposed Peer Evaluators Policy defines the requirements and responsibilities of the Commission to utilize competent, knowledgeable, and qualified peer evaluators who adhere to a code of conduct. Following member review and comment earlier this year, the Commission approved the policy at its June meeting. If approved by membership, the policy and its related Peer Evaluators Procedures will become effective September 1, 2018. The Peer Evaluators Policy and Peer Evaluators Procedures will replace the current [Guidelines, Selection of Peer Evaluators](#).
